

Trelowarren House and the Stable Event Space

Trelowarren is a unique and romantic place for your wedding and reception or a celebration of any kind. The house was the inspiration for Daphne Du Maurier's Navron House in her novel Frenchman's Creek and has been a family home for the Vyvyans since 1427. It has the romance of old Cornwall and was described by the writer as 'a jewel' of a house.

We have a Wedding License to hold Civil Marriage Ceremonies in the Drawing Room, the Library and the Hall - and the beautiful Gothic Chapel is perfect for a wedding celebration. \*



For the Reception we recommend that you have the lovely ceremony in the house or Chapel, and perhaps a champagne reception in the Drawing Room/on the lawn, followed by the Reception in the Stable Event Space just across the lawn.



For the hire of Trelowarren House (Library, Drawing Room, Hall & Staircase, the Chapel & the stable event space, prices start at £8500 (inc VAT). This price includes Hazel Parsons, the Wedding Planners, who will liaise with you to put together a perfect day and be there on the day to make sure everything runs smoothly.



For the hire of the three bedrooms in the house on a B&B basis - £500 per night.

The hire period (excluding the bedrooms) is for the day before (9am -5pm), the day of the event (until 11.30pm) and the morning afterwards (until 12.00 noon). Timings are in the contract.

In 2023 the booking prices may increase by *up to* 5% but will be fixed and agreed in the contract.
